Institute Information

Join the hundreds of AP® and Pre-AP™ teachers who have received invaluable summer training at the UALR Advanced Placement Summer Institutes (APSI). The 14th Annual UALR Advanced Placement Institute features sessions for beginning and experienced AP teachers.

Faculty: All consultants are AP or Pre-AP teachers endorsed by the College Board. They include AP Exam readers and AP award winners, and they serve as lead consultants for other regional AP Institutes. In addition, outstanding faculty from UALR and other institutions serve as guest faculty throughout the Institutes.

Location:

Session 1: June 23-27, 2008 The UALR AP Summer Institutes for English and social studies are held at the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, 1801 S. University Avenue, Little Rock, Arkansas. This site will allow the Institutes to take advantage of the Clinton Library, Central Arkansas Library, Wildwood Park for the Performing Arts, Historic Arkansas Museum and other capitol city resources.

Session 2: July 21-25, 2008 The UALR AP Summer Institutes for math, science, Spanish, music, and studio art are held at the Arkansas School for Mathematics, Sciences and the Arts, 200 Whittington Avenue, Hot Springs, Arkansas. The historic city of Hot Springs National Park was the first federally protected area in the nation's history. Enjoy historic Bath House Row and a relaxing spa in the 147° thermal water.

Tuition: The \$500 tuition includes breakfast, lunch, snacks, Vertical Teams Guides for Pre-AP teachers, College Board packets and all materials. On site campus lodging is available for an additional \$75. Dinners are the responsibility of the participant.

Accommodations: Lodging is available on site in campus dorms. All rooms are double occupancy. You may request your roommate on your registration form. Some single rooms with shared bath are available for an additional \$50 paid by the participant or school district.

Attendance: Participants must attend the entire Institute in order to earn the state-required certificate and to be eligible for state reimbursements. ***There are no excused absences.*** College Board approved Certificate of Attendance will be provided by APSI on Friday at the end of the last session. Daily sessions are from 8:30 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. Evening activities are optional.

Social Security Number: Registrant social security number is required on the report sent to the Arkansas Department of Education as confirmation of attendance and training.

Late Registration: Registration due date is four weeks before the Institute start date. A \$50 late registration fee is due for registrations received after May 25 for the June 23-27 Institute and after June 22 for the July 21-25 Institute.

Registration Confirmation: Confirmation will be emailed to the participant, and Institute information packets will be mailed to registrant's home address in May and June. If you do not receive a confirmation 4 weeks before the Institute begins, please contact Paulette at pmedison@ualr.edu or call 501.569.3410.

Registrant Replacement: If a registrant is unable to attend the Institute, the school district may substitute a replacement ***in the same content area*** (such as New Pre-AP Middle School English) at any time. If the substitute is

in a different content area (such as Exp Pre-AP Middle School English), the school district must contact the APSI office at 501.569.3410 for space availability.

Registrant Cancellation: Participants are responsible for notifying the Center of changes to their registration status. Notification of cancellation must be in writing and can be emailed to pmedison@ualr.edu. Cancellations received after June 1, 2008 or July 1, 2008 will be charged a \$100 processing fee. **School districts will be charged \$500 for all cancellations received after June 18, 2008 for English and social studies or July 15, 2008 for math, science, art, Spanish, and music.**

Clothing and Climate: Dress for class is casual and comfortable. Because summer days in Arkansas are hot and humid, light clothing is essential. All classrooms, however, are well air-conditioned, and because some can be cold, it is advisable to pack a sweater or jacket.

Schedule: Sessions begin on Monday with an opening orientation at 8:30 am and end at noon on Friday. Check in is from 7:00 – 8:30 am on Monday. Early Institute check-in is available from 3:00 – 5:30 on Sunday. Participants staying in the dorm may also check-in from 3:00 – 5:30 pm.

Course Cancellation: Every effort is made to maintain Institute course offerings. However, events such as instructor illness, inclement weather, or insufficient enrollment may require schedule adjustment or cancellation. We will notify participants of any changes to the published information. If an Institute course is cancelled, participants will be notified by email by June 1 for Session 1 or July 1 for Session 2.

Arkansas Department of Education Grants: The Arkansas Advanced Placement Professional Development Center received a grant from the Arkansas Department of Education to fund Pre-AP and AP teacher training. The Grants will be awarded in the following priority.

Priority 1. New AP teachers who have never attended an AP Summer Institute in their content area and AP teachers trained in their content area 4 or more years ago.

Priority 2. AP teachers who have been trained in the last 3 years in their content area.

Priority 3. New and Experienced **Pre-AP** teachers.

Grant money available after April 1, 2008, will be allocated based on the date the registration is received from the school district. Once grant funds are exhausted, districts are responsible for the registration fee.

Credit Option: The University of Arkansas at Little Rock will offer three hours of graduate credit for participating in the Institute and completing additional course work. Participants seeking graduate credit must apply online for acceptance into the graduate school by going to www.ualr.edu/graddept/ by March 15. Official copies of transcripts, faxed copies of teacher licensure and vaccination records must be received before file is reviewed for acceptance. Applicants can track their status online and will be notified by email of their acceptance. Once accepted by the graduate school, participants who choose the credit option register for the course online. Register for the course after March 20 by visiting <https://boss.ualr.edu>, and enroll in GATE 7393 – Teaching Advanced Placement. Tuition is the responsibility of the registrant; it is not included in the Institute fee. Scholarships: Scholarships may be available to Arkansas residents through the University of Arkansas at Little Rock. Preference will be given to graduate students enrolled in the TAVP AP Certificate program. If scholarships are awarded, the scholarship will be applied by the university and a refund check for the amount of the scholarship will be mailed to your home address.
