2012-2013 Art Department Scholarships

Use of Scholarships:

The Department of Art Scholarships may be used for tuition and fees, books and art materials for the academic year of 2012-2013, excluding summer. The scholarships typically range from \$1,200.00 to \$7,000.00 depending on funding and the specific rules of individual scholarships. The scholarships will be awarded in two installments with the first half paid at the beginning of the fall semester and the second at the beginning of the spring semester. Students must remain eligible in order to receive the second installment.

Recipient Qualifications:

- Applicants must be full- or half-time, declared Art Majors and be pursuing a degree at UALR.
- Students must be in "Good" academic standing with the university.
- Recipients must participate in the yearly Scholarship Exhibition.
- Recipients shall write a letter of appreciation to the Donors, which shall serve as their official notice of acceptance.

Selection Process:

The art department scholarship committee will identify candidates based on the Recipient Qualifications and Application Materials stated. Department of Art faculty will make the final selection. If no qualified candidates are identified, funds will be retained for use in the next academic year.

Notification:

Art Scholarship award winners will be notified by the end of April. All award winners are required to attend the College of Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences award ceremony in May.

Materials Required for Application:

Applicants will need to supply the following materials in order to be considered for the 2012-2013 Art Department Scholarships in Art, Art Education, Applied Design and Art History:

- A completed 2011-2013 Art Scholarship Application Form
 - An unofficial BOSS transcript or Official Transcript
 - Examples of work pertaining to degree sought.
- See below for specific requirements.

For an Art History applicant:

- Two typed research papers 10-15 pages for Graduate and Undergraduate student or 5-10 pages for incoming Freshman of text on an art history topic. Include supplemental materials such as illustrations and bibliography. These pages are not included in the text. Submit as hard copy and on a CD.

For a Studio Art or Applied Design applicant:

- A CD PowerPoint presentation of 8-10 *works*. Each work may show more than one view or additional detail images. However, the number of images submitted can not be more than 20.
- Typed image list. The image list must list presented materials in order (be in the order of presented materials) and must include the following information: artist name, title of work, medium used, size, and date of completion.

For an Art Education applicant:

- Two typed research papers 10-15 pages for Graduate and Undergraduate student or 5-10 pages for incoming Freshman of text on an art education topic. Include supplemental materials such as illustrations and bibliography. These pages are not included in the text. Submit as hard copy and on a CD.

OR

- A CD PowerPoint presentation of 8-10 *works*. Each work may show more than one view or additional detail images. However, the number of images submitted can not be more than 20.
- Typed image list. The image list must list presented materials in order (be in the order of presented materials) and must include the following information: artist name, title of work, medium used, size, and date of completion.
