Collaboration

UALR and TCC have developed a unique initiative to meet the demand for interpreters with Bachelor of Arts degrees in Oklahoma and Northwest Arkansas. Students will complete TCC's Associate of Arts degree in Interpreting (or equivalent) and transition into UALR's BA degree in Interpretation: ASL/English, which will be delivered to them in the Tulsa area using a variety of distance technologies. All students admitted to the BA program will complete a minor in Educational Interpreting.

DISTANCE DELIVERY PLAN

The program utilizes web-enhanced courses during regular semesters with some on-site requirement (in Tulsa or Little Rock), online courses, and interactive video classrooms.

NOTE: Courses may require independent use of the TCC language laboratory to complete assignments.

18 HOURS

- 9 hours of minor course upper level (3000—4000) electives within the content areas of child development, language acquisition, and working with diverse populations and with advisor approval.



Students must attain an overall GPA of 2.00 in all work attempted and attain a grade of C or better in all program courses.

AAS AND AA GRADUATES FROM OTHER INSTITUTIONS

Students who graduated from TCC with the AAS degree (prior to 2007) are required to complete any general education deficiencies prior to admission to the BA program. Graduates from other AA/AAS interpreting programs must meet all degree requirements of TCC's AA prior to admission.
