Bachelor of Social Work Curriculum Advising Sheet

For formal admission into the program, the student must have completed 53 credit hours (40 of which must be CORE), must have an **overall GPA of 2.5**, and must have a **cumulative GPA of 2.5** in the following prerequisite courses: **SOWK 1301: Intro to Social Work**, **SOCI 2300: Intro to Sociology**, and **PSYC 2300: Psychology & the Human Experience**. In addition, the application process requires an application form, a personal statement from the student, two letters of reference, and official transcripts from all colleges or universities attended with the exception of UALR.
