This VIP day will give gifted, scholarship-eligible students an exclusive inside look at UALR; no other city in Arkansas matches Little Rock's opportunities for student internships, research projects, business and political connections, and involvement in the arts. We encourage you to come see for yourself.

You'll meet UALR students and alumni and get a chance to ask them why living and learning in a cultural city will make such a difference in your education. The day-long event will include special "preview" classes, one-on-one discussions with faculty, a campus tour, lunch, and an informative session for parents that will cover topics such as financial aid, housing, and campus safety.

Depending on your college entrance exam scores and the strength of your transcript, you may be offered a scholarship package that day worth \$8,000 to \$50,000 over four years. To determine your eligibility, we will need your high school transcript, ACT score, and a completed online admission application by October 30th. YES! I want to find out if I am eligible for a scholarship and possibly receive a scholarship award on November 13. In order for the university to review your record for scholarship eligibility, it is your responsibility to send to UALR:

- ✓ **Your Official High School Transcript:** a sealed copy should be sent to Keesha Johnson, Assistant Dean of Student Services, UALR, AHSS, Fine Arts 210, University of Arkansas at Little Rock, 2801 S. University Ave, Little Rock, AR 72204-1099 **OR** your high school may send your transcript electronically to the UALR Office of Admissions. Ask your high school counselor for assistance.
- ✓ **Your best ACT score:** if your score is not on your high school transcript, or if you have not requested that the score be sent to UALR, then you will need to have your scores sent directly to UALR. The UALR ACT school code is **0132**. You may send this information to UALR online at www.act.org.
- ✓ **Your online application for admission to UALR** <http://ualr.edu/admissions/>: An application fee of \$40 is required. If you qualify for a scholarship award on November 13, but have not applied by that date, university Admissions staff can assist you with your application on site. The \$40 admission application fee will be required; a check or credit card can be used to pay the application fee.
