Job Description

Temporary Employment – Summer of 2017

Engineering Section, Arkansas Department of Health (ADH)

The ADH is planning on hiring two “Engineer Technician” positions during the summer of 2017. The duration of employment is a maximum of 90 days. Pay is approximately \$14.76 per hour. Working hours are normally 40 hours per week, but will likely exceed 8 hours on some days.

The job duties include extensive travel to water supply sources, water treatment plants, and to water sample sites, collection of water samples and completion of paper water sample collection forms, collection of physical measurements, assessment of physical condition of facilities and equipment, collection of electronic data collection using a handheld Trimble GPS unit, and checking the accuracy of water quality monitoring equipment. Other job duties may be assigned. Adequate training on all job duties will be provided on the job.

The positions are based out of the Health Department main building at 4815 West Markham Street in Little Rock. Weekly in-state travel is required with some overnight stays. Some travel will be day trips to and from Little Rock and some trips will involve spending several nights out. Travel expenses will be reimbursed in accordance with state policies.

You must be a US citizen or have a “green card”. A current valid driver’s license is also a job requirement. Travel will be by state vehicle and will be statewide. Preferred education: completion of sophomore year of curriculum in Civil, Chemical, Environmental or Biological Engineering from an ABET accredited program. Two years of training or education in engineering or a related field is required.

Complete the state application, print and sign the application. Applications must be submitted directly to the ADH-Engineering Section and must be received by 4:30 PM on Friday, March 17, 2017.
