Some lobby manager positions will be available during the break. Contact your hall director if you are interested in working to help offset the cost. West Hall **will not** be open for residents to sign up to stay.

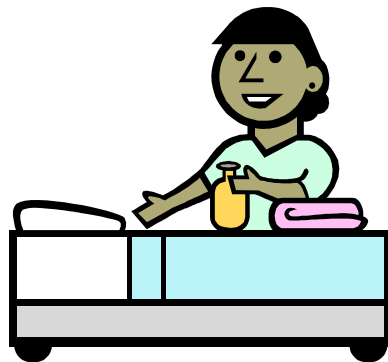


23-Hour Quiet Hours

5. On the first floor, make sure your blinds are down and closed.

8. Turn your air or heat to the "off" position.
9. Turn in your key waiver to your RA.

For the dates of December 13—January 14 (excluding December 20—January 2) will be:

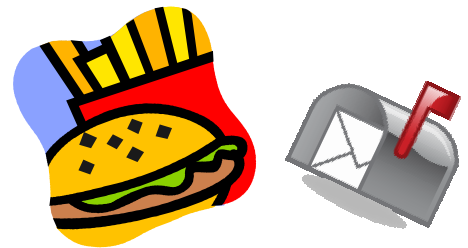
