**Grace Periods:** Students who have maintained valid F-1 or J-1 status are eligible for a grace period after finishing their program. During this time you may travel within the U.S. and make plans to leave, transfer your SEVIS record to another school, or apply to USCIS for a Change of Status. You may not use an expired I-20 or DS-2019 to re-enter the U.S., even during an eligible grace period.

**F-1 students:** 60-day grace period **J-1 students:** 30-day grace period
