# German Cultural Olympics

The German Cultural Olympics featuring five categories is open to both high school and college students, who will compete in separate divisions. Individuals are invited to submit entries for the essay, speech, visual art, and songwriting/poetry contests; and individuals or groups of up to three people are invited to submit entries for the short film contest. All entries must be written or performed in English, but the topic must deal with Germany.

Judges from the UALR faculty and the Little Rock community will select the local winners, whose entries will be sent to the German Embassy in Washington, D.C., to be judged against those from other *Do Deutsch Weeks* around the country. The national winner in each category will receive a trip to Germany.

Each individual may only submit one entry.

However, schools may have multiple submissions per category.

Please include a photograph of the entrant or entrants with your submission.

## **Speech Competition:**

Each entrant must write and present a 3- to 5-minute speech on the subject of German-American relations and submit a digital video of the speech. Speeches will be judged based on content, delivery, organization, and originality.

## **Essay Competition:**

Each entrant must write a 2- to 3-page essay (12-point Times, double-spaced, 1-inch margins) on the subject of German influences in America. The essay must be submitted to [DoGermanUALR@gmail.com](mailto:DoGermanUALR@gmail.com) as a .doc or .txt file. Essays will be judged based on content, language, organization, and originality.

## **Visual Arts Competition:**

Each entrant must produce an original, two-dimensional work of art (poster, collage, painting, etc.) that draws upon the themes of German language and culture. All entries must be static and physical works of art – i.e., no digital video (see Video Competition below) or purely electronic works. A digital photo of the finished artwork must be submitted by the deadline. Art will be judged based on content, creativity, and artistic expression.

## **Songwriting/Poetry Competition:**

Entrants must compose an original song or write an original poem that deals with Germany, its language, or its influences in the U.S. in a musical or lyrical way. A .wav or .mp3 recording of the song or poem must be submitted by the deadline. Entries will be judged based on content, creativity, artistic expression, and performance.

## **Video Competition:**

Each entrant or team must produce a digital video, up to 5 minutes long, that portrays German influences on the daily lives of Americans. The complete video must be submitted in .wmv, MPEG or Quicktime format by the deadline. Please either burn a DVD or upload the file to *Vimeo* (see left). Films will be judged based on content, creativity, organization, and research. This category is open to individuals or teams of up to three students.
