- _____ 3. Successfully completed or be enrolled in 4 credit hours of Anatomy and Physiology: Biol 1411, Biol 1412 or equivalent with a grade of C or better.
- _____ 4. Have a minimum 2.6 GPA in completed required nursing general education courses.
- _____ 5. Submit a completed Department of Nursing Application Form with copies of all college/university transcripts.
- _____ 7. Complete scheduled EVOLVE A2 and request score submission to the department or submit score report with the application.
- _____ 8. ESL students must have TOEFL scores of 83 (internet exam),207 (computerized exam) or 540 (paper exam).
