About Rouen, France

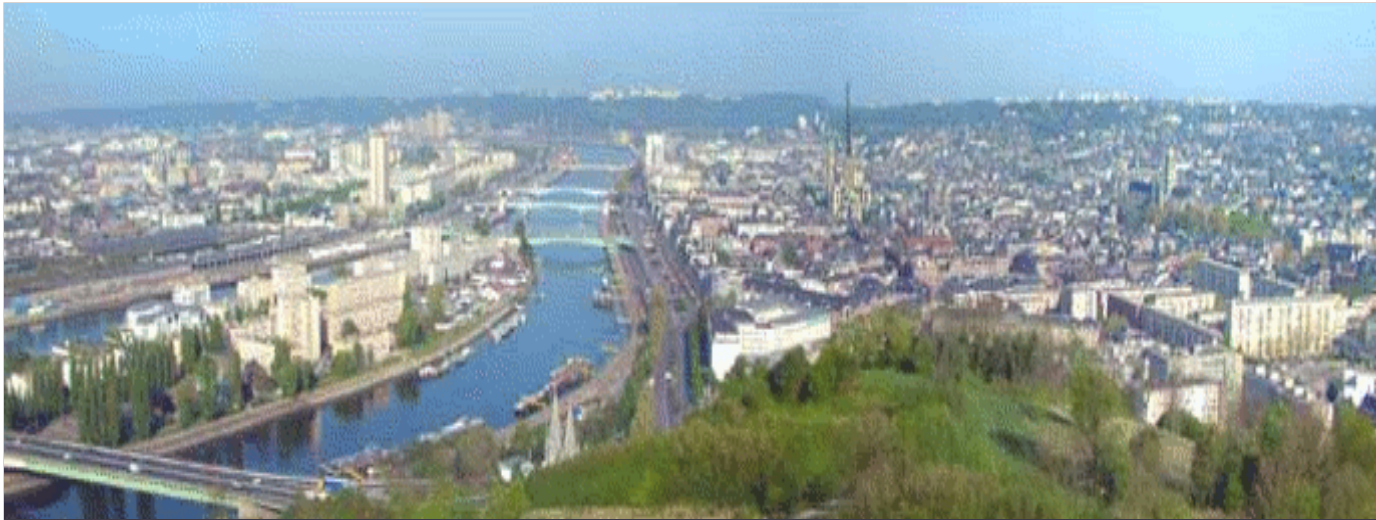
Rouen, which currently has a metropolitan population of over half a million people, is one of the most historic cities in all of France. It is situated in northern France on the River Seine and is currently the capital of the *Haute-Normandie* region. The city is notable for its cathedral (which is the subject of a series of famous Monet paintings), as the home of author Gustave Flaubert, and as the site of Joan of Arc's execution. Rouen's annual average temperatures range from 35°F to 75°F. Paris is a little more than an hour away via train.
