



# Ludwigshafen University of Applied Science - Germany

## About the city Ludwigshafen

The city is located on the Rhine opposite to Mannheim, in the southwest of Germany. The twin cities form one large agglomeration separated by the river; 163,000 inhabitants live in Ludwigshafen and 311,000 in Mannheim. The total metropolitan area has about 2.4 million inhabitants.

Politically a part of Rhineland-Palatinate, Ludwigshafen is historically and economically more an integral part of the Rhine-Neckar Metropolitan Region and the Rhine-Neckar Triangle, whose name is derived from the shape given by the influence of the Rhine and Neckar rivers. This region cuts across political boundaries artificially imposed after World War II.

The region is well-known for its international businesses including, DaimlerChrysler AG, La Roche Mannheim GmbH, John Deere, Siemens AG, as well as many small and medium-sized companies.

In addition to being an economic hub, the region is also known for its academic and research network including the Universities of Heidelberg, Mannheim and Ludwigshafen which altogether have over 45,000 students.

The Rhine-Neckar region is an area of particular natural beauty and diversity flanked by the Palatinate Forest to the West and 'Odenwald' Forest to the East. It also presents an array of historical and architectural treasures.

Ludwigshafen is located in Germany's warmest region with temperatures ranging from 32°F in the winter, to 85°F in the summer. The humidity is high, which leads to many thunderstorms in the summer, similar to Little Rock's weather!



## About the University



Ludwigshafen University of Applied Science delivers excellent teaching and research in the major areas of Business Studies. It has a compact main campus situated just outside of the center of Ludwigshafen with 3000 full-time students. There are lecture halls, seminar rooms, a cafeteria, a library and state-of-the-art computing equipment. Some classes are taught on the two smaller campuses.

Ludwigshafen University of Applied Sciences consists of a central administration unit and shared services, three departments, teaching institutes affiliated with the departments and several research centers.

## Housing

Ludwigshafen offers a variety of accommodation options and locations. The two main choices are:

- Student residence hall:

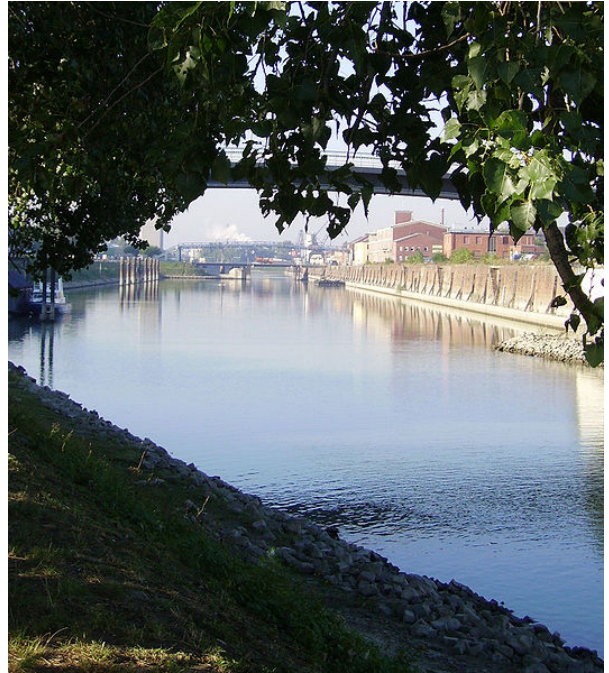
One-person apartments furnished with a bed, desk, chair and internet. The residence hall is situated by downtown Ludwigshafen and is about 5 to 10 minutes away from the University by bus. \$300/330 a month + \$400 deposit.\*

- Room in student's apartment :

Two or three bedroom apartments where you may choose to share a room. All of these apartments are fully furnished but do not come with an Internet connection (you will have to set up and pay for your own connection).

The price of these apartments varies between \$230 and \$330\* a month, which will depend on whether you are sharing a room and your proximity to campus. The deposit will be around \$300\*.
