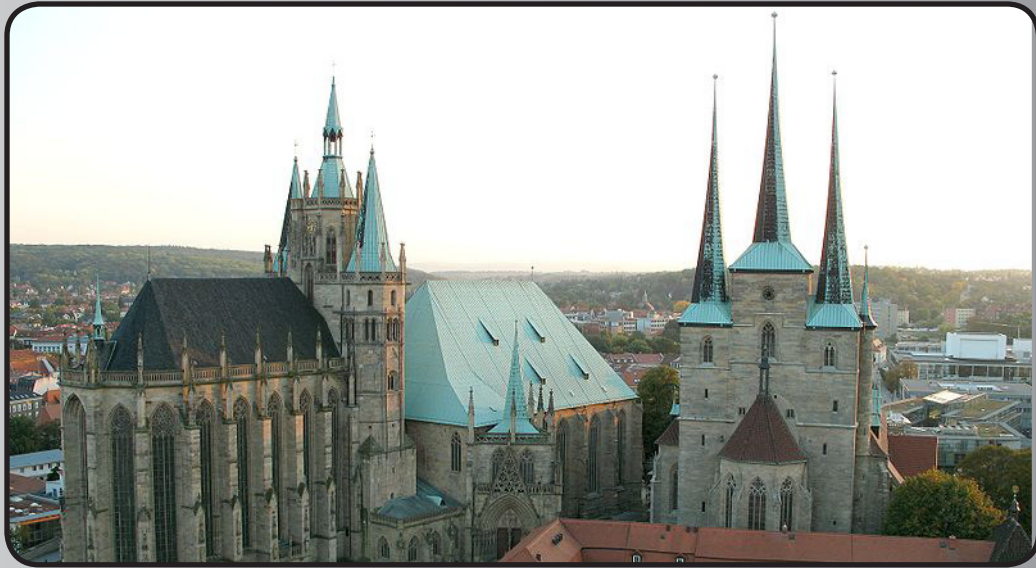


Erfurt University - Germany



About Erfurt

Erfurt is the capital of the German Federal state of Thuringia and its largest city with around 200,000 inhabitants. Erfurt is centrally located in Germany, which makes it a great city to visit while in the country. You can easily access Berlin, Frankfurt, or Hannover by train, plane or car.

The economy of the city relies mainly on services and tourism. Erfurt has preserved an intact medieval city center. The city is famous for its cathedral and churches that tower above the townscape.

The climate in Erfurt is quite cool, with temperatures ranging from 25°F in February to 75°F in July and August.

About Erfurt University of Applied Science

Erfurt University of Applied Science was founded in 1991. Today, about 4,200 students are enrolled and are studying in a modern environment. Approximately 1,000 of these students are freshmen. UAS Erfurt offers 11 different areas of study from Scientific-Technical, Social and Economics to Arts.

It is known for its combination of scientific training and its practical applications. Classes consist of a mix of lectures, seminars and exercises. The University is comprised of six colleges:

- Applied Social Sciences
- Architecture
- Civil Engineering and Conservation/Restoration
- Engineering in Building and Computer Science
- Landscape Architecture, Horticulture, Forestry
- Business, Logistics and Transport

Accommodation and meals

The Department of Student Living offers a service packet for international students. With the service packet, the cost of accommodations and cafeteria tokens is already paid before the beginning of your first semester. The packet includes a furnished single room, one set of linens, food tokens to use in the University's cafeteria, Internet access, a semester ticket to use the local public transportation for free, and many more useful items. There is a choice between two categories of comfort for the rooms. Category one costs \$2000* per semester, category two costs \$2300*

Students that do not wish to purchase this packet can either go to the Department of Student Living or to the Department of International Office of UAS Erfurt, which helps exchange students find a room. Single apartments, single rooms or two-bedroom rooms are available.

Several cafeterias are located throughout the University and the city of Erfurt.

Activities

There are numerous sports facilities in Erfurt, including an ice arena accessible to all.

The Department of Student Living organizes meetings between Erfurt citizens and foreign students, as well as the "Café International".

Classes available

German language students may take courses at different levels in the UAS Erfurt language center. They can also take German language courses - free of charge - at the Language Center of Erfurt University and at the Bauhaus University in Weimar if it has been approved by the Erfurt International Office.

Business majors, even if they do not take German can participate in the summer Business Program where Business classes are all taught in English.
