

What is the Senior Justice Center?

The Senior Justice Center, directed by Dr. David Montague, was founded in 2005 and is the only center in the nation using undergraduate student interns to address crime against the elderly.

Housed in UALR's Department of Criminal Justice, our Mission is to address crimes against the elderly, at the grass roots and policy level via community seminars, presenting at scholarly conferences, serving on boards/commissions, operating a

hotline, and completing research.

Senior Justice has made a positive impact and received tremendous publicity since its birth. The center's primary visibility comes from its community based seminars where student interns present crime information to seniors via scenarios (a criminal justice training technique).

At the policy level, Senior Justice is actively involved in the societal effort to address crime against the elderly by contributing enormously to research at the State Legislature's Arkansas-2020 Study and the Arkansas Adult Protective Services Task Force.

Educating current and future professionals that work with the elderly is an additional goal of Senior Justice. This is achieved by working with the Arkansas Medicare/Medicaid Fraud Patrol, and the UALR Graduate Gerontology Certificate Program.

Senior Justice actively collaborates with the UALR Juvenile Justice Center to help close the gap between youth views and senior views of each other.

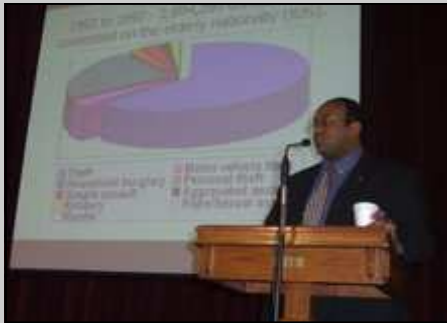
UALR Senior Justice Center and You
