## Student Support Services

The Student Support Services program offers tutoring, academic skills development, and guidance and counseling, with emphasis on developing strategies for succeeding in college. All services are free and available to any student who lacks adequate preparation and qualifies under federal guidelines.

## Grant funds and Scholarships are available.

A limited number of eligible students will be accepted from each eligibility category listed below:

- Students who are first generation (neither parent has a four-year college degree) AND who qualify under certain income criteria.
- Students who are first generation OR qualify under certain income criteria
- Students with a disability

Students must also have an academic need and demonstrate college success.
