UALR Benton approved to provide training for eligible WIOA recipients

The UALR Benton Center has been approved by the Central Arkansas Planning and Development District, Inc. as an eligible training provider for students seeking a bachelor's degree in E-Commerce. This means that individuals meeting certain requirements may be eligible to receive financial award for college tuition, fees, books and school supplies from the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) program.

The WIOA program is administered through the Arkansas Workforce Center, located at 400 Edison Avenue in Benton. The program is designed to help job seekers access employment, education, training, and support services to succeed in the labor market and to match employers with the skilled workers they need to compete in the global economy.

An E-Commerce degree prepares students for careers in the latest web, social media, and business technologies. The E-Commerce program extends across multiple disciplines including: information technology, business, and an area of study selected by the student such as graphic design, IT security, project management, marketing, advertising, entrepreneurship, or advanced writing skills.

"The employment potential for E-Commerce graduates is vast and expected to increase in the future," Bruce Bauer UALR E-commerce instructor at UALR Benton, said. "E-Commerce graduates find lucrative careers building websites, managing sales, creating and executing online marketing campaigns, and performing other responsibilities related to selling products and promoting businesses. Others work as web content developers, social media managers, programmers, or webmasters for a variety of industries."

Who qualifies?

Individuals who meet certain income guidelines may be eligible. Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) recipients, Dislocated Workers, TEA, or SSI recipients automatically qualify. Those interested should go to the Arkansas Workforce Center to complete a Workforce Center Registration packet.

Documentation such as proof of income, citizenship, identity, age, etc. will be required. Applicants being considered for WIOA training services must complete an assessment. Applicants will be selected to receive funding based on the recommendation of a selection committee.
