Admission to the College of Business students must have: Completed Math 1302 College Algebra and RHET 1312 Composition II with a grade of "C" or better and have a minimum of 2.25 overall GPA (at UALR and/or at transferring school) or have a minimum of 2.25 on the most recently completed 15 hours at UALR (The GPA on the most recent 15 hours will be calculated on all hours attempted during the semester(s) in which the 15 hours requirement is met. GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS: 2.0 GPA major, minor and overall.
