- Have a minimum of 2.25 overall GPA (at UALR and or at transferring school) or
- Have a minimum of 2.25 on the most recently completed 15 hours at UALR (The GPA on the most recent 15 hours will be calculated on all hours attempted during the semester(s) in which the 15 hours requirement is met).

Without being officially admitted to the College of Business, students may take business courses as long as all prerequisites for these courses have been met. However, students may not take the capstone course MGMT 4380 until officially admitted into the College.

Graduation Requirements: 2.0 GPA major, minor, and overall. C or better on all Major Courses.
