



The Donaghey Scholars Program

Since its beginning in 1984, the Donaghey Scholars Program has matured into a distinctive and distinguished honors program. The program has approximately 100 students on campus and fosters intimacy and a genuine sense of community. The comprehensive and highly structured curriculum features interdisciplinary team-taught, seminar-format courses that replace the university's general education core. These courses emphasize primary texts, critical thinking, active debate, and writing. Scholars study abroad during their time in the program, gaining experience in their field of study or fluency in a second language. Graduating scholars are prepared as "generalists" ready to contribute to their fields and to society.

The program's faculty come from across campus and are distinguished for their scholarly and creative productivity and the spirit they bring to the Scholars classroom. Donaghey Scholars represent a diverse mix of backgrounds, abilities, and interests, and include nontraditional and international students. Upon graduation, many enter directly into successful careers and many others continue to thrive at graduate and professional schools such as Harvard, Yale, Oxford, Vanderbilt, Stanford, UA Little Rock, and other prestigious universities. We are proud of this year's Donaghey Scholars graduates and all Scholars for their commitment to intellectual achievement and personal growth.

Edward Lynn Whitbeck Memorial Award = Ahad Nadeem



The Whitbeck Memorial Award is presented to an outstanding graduating senior with demonstrated excellence in scholarship, leadership, citizenship, and character. Ahad Nadeem, the 2023 recipient, has demonstrated outstanding citizenship through various research and activities aimed at bettering the lives of others. From working to combat child hunger to educating people about opioids, Nadeem has worked to address problems in the community.

Nadeem's concern about student success led him to offer free math tutoring to elementary students. At UA Little Rock, he served as president of the Campus Garden Alliance and was vice president of the Student Government Association. He worked with the student senate on campus safety and other initiatives. Nadeem also promoted campus engagement and served as a class representative for the Donaghey Scholars Student Committee. Passionate about science education, he

served as a Genetics learning assistant in the classroom. He presented research on food insecurity and on the genetic programming of fat tissue. The aspiring physician was also a health and wellness writer for the university's student newspaper. His community service also included volunteering at the UAMS Cancer Center, the UAMS NICU, and a center that supports grieving children.

Undergraduate Honors

To graduate Summa Cum Laude, a student must have earned a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.90.

To graduate Magna Cum Laude, a student must have earned a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.70.

To graduate Cum Laude, a student must have earned a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.50.

To graduate with an associate degree with Honors, a student must have earned a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.70 and not have completed more than 83 credit hours.

NOTICE: The list of candidates for Fall 2023 graduation was prepared before final grades were reported and inclusion herein does not constitute evidence of graduation. Final action to ensure an accurate listing of names of all persons qualified for degrees cannot be

taken before this program was published. This listing of a name in this program should not be construed as an indication that the person will in fact receive a degree at this commencement. Conversely, the absence of a name from the program list does not necessarily mean that the person will not be awarded a degree. This program included all those who applied to graduate in Fall 2023 prior to November 1, 2023 and all students who were conferred degrees in Summer 2023. Final honors for Fall 2023 applicants will be calculated after final grades are posted during graduation checkout. Summer 2023 graduates have a confirmed and final honors designation that is notated on their diploma and transcript. Fall 2023 graduation applicants have an honors designation that is calculated with all graded courses taken through Summer 2023.

Commencement

An Ending and a Beginning Steeped in Tradition

UA Little Rock's commencement exercise, a ceremony filled with pomp, color, and music, is steeped in traditions, some of which date back to the Middle Ages. Now, as then, commencement is the opportunity for a university to demonstrate that it has fulfilled its basic missions: educating people to become leaders in professions and society, and awarding the degrees that represent their work and achievements as scholars. Commencement means "beginning," but it comes at the end of a student's academic experience, marking the beginning of a graduate's life as the holder of a degree.

Chancellor's Medallion – During UA Little Rock's graduation, a silver chain and medallion bearing the UA Little Rock official seal and the name and dates of service of each past Chancellor are worn by Chancellor Christina S. Drale, who represents the entire university.

The Mace – One of the lesser known artifacts connected with commencement is the mace, which today is a ceremonial device, borne with great dignity into commencement halls, signifying that those who follow are persons of authority and achievement. The mace, carried by the Grand Marshal, was designed and hand-crafted in purple heart, mulberry, and bronze by artist Jack R. Slentz while he was a graduate teaching assistant in sculpture in the UA Little Rock Department of Art, working under the supervision of Michael Warrick.

Banners – Banners and standards have long marked significant assemblies—armies, churches, and powerful families. During UA Little Rock's commencement, you will see a maroon, silver and white banner carried into the hall at the head of each college group.

Marshals – The leader of the academic procession is the Grand Marshal who carries the mace in the port arms position as they enter the hall. At UA Little Rock, the Grand Marshal is the president of the UA Little Rock Assembly – the university faculty's governing body for academic issues. Today's Grand Marshal is Joanne Matson. You will also see faculty and student marshals who have been selected to lead groups of candidates for graduation to their seating in the hall.

Music – The sequence of the musical program today with featured music, processionals, and recessionals is traditional.

The Dais Party – The last retinue to enter the commencement hall will be seated on the dais, where much of the ceremony will be conducted. The dais party includes the Chancellor, Provost, Vice Chancellors, Deans, other university officials and guests, and representatives of the UA Little Rock Board of Visitors, University of Arkansas System, and UA Board of Trustees.

Academic Regalia – The tradition of distinctive academic attire originated in Europe in the 12th century. A black scholar's gown and black square hat, known as the mortarboard, are almost universally used in the U.S. for holders of the bachelor's degree. Some universities authorize robes of different colors for holders of doctoral degrees, who have three velvet stripes on the sleeves of their robes and wear colorful hoods that extend down their backs. Those with master's degrees wear robes with closed sleeves and arms extended through slits in the body of the gown. Master's hoods are slightly shorter than those worn by doctoral degree holders. Candidates for undergraduate degrees (associate and baccalaureate) wear maroon tassels. Candidates for graduate degrees wear black tassels, while doctoral candidates, as well as those who hold doctoral degrees, wear gold or silver tassels.

UA Little Rock Variations – UA Little Rock has made few changes in commencement since 1928, when the school, then known as Little Rock Junior College, awarded degrees to its first 12 graduates. The color of the caps and gowns was initially black, then a bright magenta-maroon shade, and then back to black.
