







## 2016-2017 Scholarships

- Funded 42 students
- \*\$110,000 range was \$500 to \$4500
- Amy Frets did an audit and found \$20,000 in a University Account from the Arkansas Contractor's Licensing Board (ACLB) from when the university accounts were set up
- ACLB funds can not be deposited into a foundation account only an university account

- Department has a total of 260 students


## Construction Management

- Master of Science has 25 students



#### **ABET PEO Review**

- Civil and Construction Engineering
- Program educational objectives (PEO's) are broad statements that describe what graduates are expected to attain within a few years after graduation.
- PEO's must be consistent with the needs of the program's constituencies.

  - Construction companies
  - Engineering design firms
  - Government agencies
  - Vendors
- Professional Societies
- Faculty
- Alumni

In other words, all of you!

#### PEO 1

Produce graduates who rapidly become certified Engineer Interns (EI) and Associate Constructors (AC) employed in architecture, engineering, construction, or related fields or pursuing graduate or professional education in engineering, business, law, architecture, etc.

#### PEO 2

Produce graduates who become licensed Professional Engineers (PE) and/or Certified Professional Constructors (CPC) after gaining the required professional experience and the requisite knowledge to pass the licensing and/or certification exams.

#### PEO 3

Produce graduates who engage in lifelong learning, through on-the-job training, participation in professional societies, additional formal education, continuing education and professional development, research, and selfstudy, in order to use state-of-the-art knowledge to design and build safe and effective buildings and/or provide high quality service to the general public, employers, clients, and other professionals.




