1. Minutes from the February 3rd meeting were reviewed. Yupo motioned to approved, Pat seconded.

2. Revised proposal for creating a data science course, entitled "IFSC 7370 Data Science and Technologies" was discussed. Committee suggested to specify prerequisite courses, viz., IFSC 2300, IFSC 3200, and STAT 2350; or equivalent. Since the course is offered at 7000 level, graduate-level prerequisite(s) (such as Database or Data mining) are recommended. The proposal was approved conditioned upon specifying the prerequisites. Yupo motioned, Pat seconded.

3. Proposal for dropping IFSC/CPSC/SYEN 7101, 7102, 7103 as a requirement from Integrated Computing IFSC PhD track was discussed. The proposal was approved. Yupo motioned, Coskun seconded.

4. Proposal for using IFSC 7370 Data Science and Technologies as a requirement rather than IFSC 7350 ECommerce was discussed. The proposal was approved. HIRAK motioned, Pat seconded.
