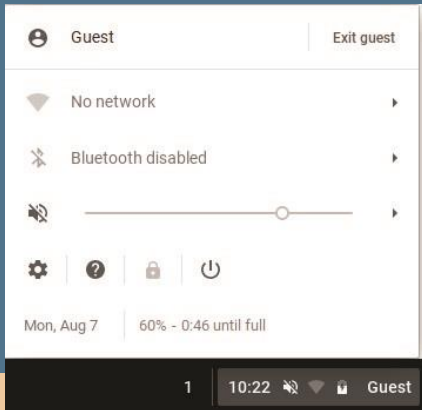
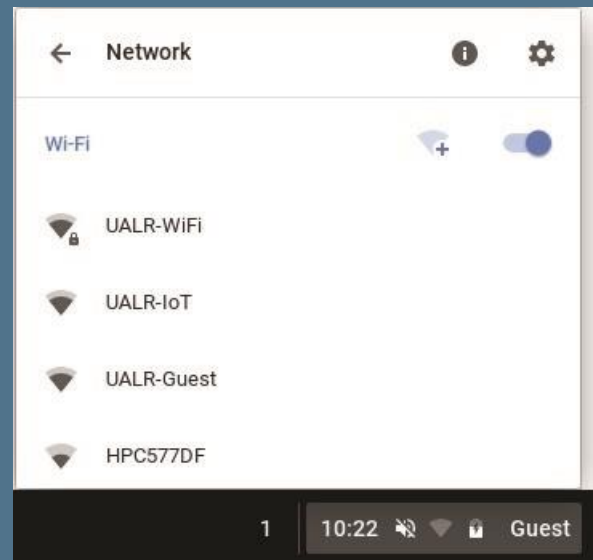


How to Connect to UA Little Rock's WiFi on a Chromebook

1. If you are logging in for the first time on your Chromebook, skip to step 4.
2. Click on the WiFi symbol in the bottom right corner.



3. Click on "No Network"



4. Click on "UALR-WiFi" you will be taken to this screen:
