Applicants must have at least a 3.0 grade point average in English. Financial need and potential for academic success will be strongly considered. If all things are equal, financial need will be the deciding factor. Applicants must submit a typed essay of no more than 600 words discussing their personal and academic goals and explaining how the Cooper Success Scholarship will help achieve those goals. The issue of financial need should also be specifically addressed. Preference will be given to students who are not already in the Cooper Honors Program.
