TRANSMITTAL OF UNIVERSITY ASSEMBLY LEGISLATION

University Assembly legislation is to be submitted to the chancellor to approve or disapprove within fifteen calendar days after the Assembly has taken action. The chancellor shall provide written reasons for disapproval to the University Assembly.

To the Chancellor of the University of Arkansas at Little Rock:

The following legislation passed the UALR Assembly on September 15, 2017.

Be it resolved that Article I of the Constitution of the University Assembly of the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, Officers of the Assembly be modified to read:

The president shall preside at meetings of the Assembly and of the Executive Committee of the Assembly. The president of the Assembly or designated elected member of the Faculty Senate Executive Committee shall have the responsibility for convening the initial meetings of the councils and elected standing committees of the Assembly and Faculty Senate in the fall semester.
