TRANSMITTAL OF FACULTY SENATE LEGISLATION

(Faculty Senate legislation is to be submitted to the chancellor to approve or disapprove within ten calendar days of the Faculty Senate action. The chancellor may approve or veto any Faculty Senate legislation within a period from the eleventh through the twenty-fifth calendar day after such action has been presented, unless the Assembly has been petitioned to amend or rescind the Faculty Senate legislation. In the latter case, the chancellor's approval or veto shall be made no later than fifteen calendar days after the Assembly has voted on and failed to approve a motion to amend or rescind a legislative action of the Faculty Senate.)

Motion FS_2013_13. Communication - Speech Criteria (Legislation, majority vote at one meeting, from Council on Core Curriculum and Policies, no second required)

Moved that the Faculty Senate adopt the following criteria in completion of the General Education Core for the Communication - Speech Curricular Area and that the name of the Curricular Area be changed to "Communication - Speech."

Courses in this area focus on developing student knowledge and skills in a variety of spoken communication contexts.
