I Call to order

President Angela Willis called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m. She then gave her "welcome" and "presidential" address including an overview of the Staff Senate's accomplishments over the past year.

II. Minutes & Treasurer Report

The minutes for the meeting of July 20, 1999 were approved. The Treasurer reported an account balance of \$103.88.

III. Changes to ByLaws

President Willis read the proposed changes to the Staff Senate By-Laws, which included the composition of the Staff Senate (1 employee benefits eligible full time or part time classified or non classified, non-faculty) for each twenty full time or part-time benefits eligible filled positions, vs. two per each twenty-five positions. In addition, a proposal to delete the use of "proxy" representatives was recommended. The first change regarding number of positions, will be implemented in the next fiscal year, and the second change regarding proxies, implemented immediately.
