Since the COB is requiring SPCH 1300 in their college core it was pointed out that this was allowed under Act 182 (Roger Phillips Transfer Act) since SPCH 1300 is a prerequisite for BINS 3380 which is a required major course for the college.

The new CSSC core, requiring SPCH 1300 and how it will be applied (or not) for those transfer students from in-state colleges and universities who have earned transferable associate's degrees under Act 182 (Roger Phillips Transfer Act) may have issues since it does not meet the allowed conditions under Act 182. Act 182 legislates that students entering the university with an associate of arts, associate of science, or associate of arts in teaching degree that is designed for transfer in accordance with Act 182 of 2009, meet the UALR core requirements. Students transferring to UALR with such degrees are not required to take additional lower-level general education courses except under the following conditions:

- As a prerequisite for courses in the transfer student's baccalaureate degree program.
- A discipline-specific course that is required by the student's baccalaureate degree program and that the student has not completed at the two-year public institution of higher education.
- A requirement of an independent licensing or accrediting body.
