#### **Other Issues Discussed**

The Council revised its application form for Graduate Faculty Status to indicate that generally speaking, applicants who are nominated to serve on thesis, dissertation, and project committees should hold an academic degree at least at the same level as the degree being awarded by the committee. In recognition that there are some extraordinarily qualified applicants who may have a lower academic degree (or none), the Council added an option to the form to petition for an exception.
