Approved Policy Changes

Graduate Student Probation

Policy (approved 10/6/21 by grad council)

Any graduate student whose cumulative GPA on all courses taken for graduate credit falls below 3.0 at the end of a semester will be placed on probation. Students will be removed from probation when their cumulative GPA is a 3.0 or above. Failure to make at least a 3.0 in each semester while on probation or receiving two or more C grades (or lower) during the probation period will result in the student being dismissed from the Graduate School. During their first semester on probation, students must meet with a Graduate School advisor in addition to their program advisor to develop a plan to regain good academic standing.

Other Issues Discussed

October 6, 2021:

Dr. Brian Berry informed the council that he has become aware of a lack of appeals process with graduate students and their advisors (i.e. removal from a lab group, what rights do students have?). He would like to look at the current appeal legislation and determine if this addresses graduate student issues and needs. If not, Dr. Berry would recommend the graduate council to consider this issue.

October 20, 2021:

The graduate council discussed possible policy changes to the Graduate School's Graduate Admission Policy (509.3) and the Graduate School International Student Admission Policy (509.9). The council discussed modifying the language of the policies related to transcripts to require transcripts only from their accredited degree granting University for the student's last 60 credit hours. We will continue to discuss and consider these policy modifications at the next meeting.
