Additional Action Item

CNMG had submitted CCFs to change the semester offered in the description of their courses (e.g., from “Fall only” to “Spring only” or vice versa). After some research, we found that CNMG was the only academic unit that still had this designation on all their courses in the catalog. After discussion with the department chair about the benefits of removing such designations from the catalog and instead maintaining such scheduling policies in departmental advising documents and on the departmental website, the department wished to remove the designation from all their courses. Instead of requiring updated forms from CNMG to remove this non-substantive wording, UGC voted to instruct the Curriculum Coordinator in the Provost’s Office to remove the “semester-offered” designations from the catalog descriptions of all CNMG courses in the 2022-23 undergraduate catalog.
