

Subject: Apply now - additional Federal Student Aid to Assist with COVID-19 Expenses

Dear UA Little Rock Students,

UA Little Rock is preparing for additional student aid disbursements from federal COVID-19 relief funds. A limited amount of funds remain available for fall 2021 to be awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis for eligible students. Please read below for additional information about obtaining financial assistance.

Additional COVID-19 Funds Fall 2021

All students, including undergraduate and graduate students, who need additional financial support during the Fall 2021 term can apply for COVID-19 relief funds by submitting the [Fall 2021 CARES Act Application](#). Funds are limited at this time and will be funded on a first-come, first-serve basis. Students must agree to use the funds for eligible expenses. The funds may be used for any component of a student's cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to the coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care), or child care. Funds are expected to be disbursed on or before December 21, 2021.

Important: Please Verify Your BankMobile Account

UA Little Rock intends to disburse the funds as quickly as possible to eligible students. To ensure there are no delays in processing, please verify you have signed up to receive refunds through BankMobile. If you are unsure of the process, or have not signed up, please review the instructions for BankMobile at ualr.edu/bursar.

UA Little Rock expects to have COVID-19 relief funds available to students during the Spring 2022 term. Once spring 2022 starts, please check your UA Little Rock email concerning additional COVID-19 relief funds available during the spring term.
