Open Forum

- Dr. Berry lead a review of the policies that the Graduate Council wants to address, as laid out at the last meeting of the 2015-2016 year.
 - "Double-dipping" policy
 - Coursework timing out- ADE has a limit of 7 years, UALR uses 5 years.
 - Dismissal policy (possibilities for changes: time frame before being allowed to come back, conditional admission)
 - Graduate students taking undergraduate work
 - Consistencies between UALR Online and on-campus programs
 - Operating Procedures for Graduate Council
 - No known policy for retroactive withdrawal from the Graduate School
- Graduate Council needs to elect a representative to the Library Committee.
- Effective as of summer 2017, if a program wants to accept below a 2.7 GPA as a Special Conditional Admission, they will need to have submitted a program change form (PCF) and have it approved before that change can be made. PCFs for that change will need to be submitted by spring.
