Dr. Barrett, assistant professor in Educational Leadership, described the Higher Education doctoral program proposal since the originator, Dr. Gilliland, is on leave. Dr. Barrett stated that the region needed a higher education degree. They will accept 3-5 students per year and their staff is able to handle the program. Dr. Barrett mentioned that an EdD doesn't carry the clout of a PhD. Dr. McAlpine asked if the PhD program would eliminate the EdD; Dr. Barrett stated that they would evaluate the continued need for the EdD program in 3-5 years if the PhD is approved. Dr. Swingen wanted to know if faculty teaching the PhD courses have PhDs; Dr. Barrett replied affirmatively. Dr. Pellicane wanted to know when they expect to see the first student: in 2011 replied Dr. Barrett.

Old Business:

- Articulation of foreign transcripts
 - The articulation of foreign transcripts policy proposed by Dr. Lewis was approved: "If you have attended foreign institutions for undergraduate or graduate work, you are required to supply official English translations of your transcripts and a document-by-document credential evaluation of your transcript."
 - o Dr. Lewis stated that the new date for catalog corrections to coordinators is April 1.
- Graduate catalog proposed changes (tabled)
 - Dr. Pellicane stated that he and Dr. Kuralt had a few more revisions. They will meet up to finish and distribute the documents for GC review prior to consideration at the next GC meeting.
- Graduate faculty status proposed changes
 - Dr. Hunter wishes to develop some guidelines for review for faculty nomination forms. The committee is considering the Applied Science format. Dr. Swingen asked if graduate council is going to have a way to review faculty status. Dr. Hunter said they are still trying to think of a way. Dr. Jennings proposed that graduate council develop guidelines for faculty seeking appointment.
