#### Report from Dr. Angela Hunter

Summer 2014 Administration Retreat

#### First day:

- Dr. Hunter attended the retreat as vice chair of the GC.
- Most of the content of the retreat was discussed at the University Assembly.
- The Huron Group discussed their preliminary findings on UALR enrollment, recruitment, retention, etc. No official report was presented, nor has an official report been distributed yet.
- Graduate programs were not discussed very much, except for enrollment numbers.
- This discussion emphasized that everyone needs to do their part to promote recruitment, enrollment, and retention.
- The Group mentioned the possibility of implementing an "early warning" system, that would catch struggling students early in the struggle and get them in contact with professionals to help.
- The Group also did some "secret shopping" across campus, posing as students. They did not do so at the Graduate School. They do recommend that more proactive work must be done by faculty and staff to help solve student problems.

## Second day:

- Discussion of large-scale University Avenue revamping:
  - UALR is working with nonprofits to revamp the University District area.
    Improving the area could be influential for drawing in graduate students.
- Ottenheimer Library remodeling:
  - Large-scale remodeling and modernizing of the first and second floors of the library is in discussion, though more funding is needed to complete it.
  - An updated space could be helpful for recruitment.

#### Conditional Admission Issue

• Dr. Hunter voiced a concern with the disparity between 9 hours being considered full time and 12 hours being required to get off conditional admission. This issue is currently being reviewed by the Curriculum Committee and will be discussed at today's GC meeting.

#### Changes to Conditional Admission, proposed by EIT:

- Dr. DeAngelis presented EIT's proposal in the last GC and Curriculum meetings.
- The main point of the proposal is to change the number of hours required to be completed before a conditional student can gain regular admission from 12 to 9.
- The language of the proposal has been revised and updated, per GC and Curriculum Comm. recommendations.
- The GC approves the updated policy, and the policy will now go before the Faculty Senate.
- GC members should speak with their faculty senators about the updated policy before it goes before the senate.

## **Dean's Report:**

- The automated system for emailing new applicants with application requirements is now running, thanks to Larry Beachler and Dana Steele.
- Soon, an emailing system that automatically notifies graduate coordinators when applications for their programs are complete will be live. Automatic, emailed decision letters will also soon be live.
- With these and other efforts, the GS is trying to make applying, enrolling, etc. as efficient and easy as possible with the resources we have.
- These new systems should cut down on errors, loss of applications, and more.
- The GS has teamed up with Dr. Sonya Premeaux of COB for recruiting visits. When Dr. Premeaux visits schools to recruit this fall, we are providing her with resources to promote the GS.
- Graduate coordinator meeting is coming up next week.

#### **Open Forum**

#### Dr. Bayrak:

- Curriculum change issues: it is difficult to track the approval of CCFs, making it hard to know if it has been officially and finally approved.
  - Dr. Bayrak suggested that more observable documentation or a tracking system needs to be implemented for the CCF approval process.
  - This process is not run by the Graduate School, but the GS will look into possible solutions.
- UAMS Faculty Status: Dr. Bayrak asked about whether UAMS faculty automatically have GFS at UALR. They do not, and must apply for it through the set process.
