# Dean's Report

- (01/30/2019) Last day to enroll.
- Five days until census day.
- Spoke about Graduate School student drop rates. Hope to see the graduate student drop list numbers change within the next four to five days.
- Spoke briefly about preliminary trend lines. Currently, trend line is going beyond the plateaued number of student enrollment within the last few years.

### Open Forum

- The need for clarification was expressed on the subject of allowing students to repeat
  courses in the upcoming retake-and-replace policy. Committee proposed the idea about
  compiling a bullet list on how this new policy could work. Committee agreed more
  research needs to occur about the logistics behind how to implement the
  retake-and-replace policy. This new policy will take effect Fall 2019.
- Spoke about the catalog policy. Deadlines were mentioned about when new information can make the next catalog (end of February). All council approval dates must be before March 1, 2019.
- Higher Learning Commission (HLC) coming to campus next year for UA Little Rock's
  major accreditation visit. HLC will be assessing university policy records. Spoke briefly
  about a policy management board that will help the university come up with a better
  system that ensures that policies are passed by the Faculty Senate in a timely manner.
- Talked about working with programs to make progress towards graduation within timelines for Master and Doctorate degrees respectively. The graduate catalog specifies that master student should complete their degree in 7 years, and doctoral students should complete their degree in 10 years. To fix potential inconsistencies across campus,

- either these deadlines need to be enforced at the Grad School level or each program on campus may have to submit its own policy for approval.
- NSF Graduate Research Fellowship Workshops start on Wednesday (02/06/2019) at 1:00 p.m. in the Ottenheimer Library Conference Room 535. Registration is still open.
- Research and Creative Works Showcase happening April 18, 2019 on campus. Five
  events will occur. One event is an expo. Four events are college events. Currently
  requesting support. Event will be open to prospective students and donors.
