1. **Post-Bac non-deg/non-cert:** These students are considered non-degree-seeking and take undergraduate courses for professional development or personal enrichment.

No advising required

2. **Post-Bac additional degree:** These students are considered degree-seeking and want to earn a second undergraduate degree at UA Little Rock.

To be advised by department in which second degree is sought
If eligible for financial aid, documentation to be completed by department in which second degree is sought

3. **Post-Bac undergrad certificate:** These students are considered degree-seeking and want to earn a UA Little Rock undergraduate certificate.

To be advised by department in which undergraduate certificate is sought
If eligible for financial aid, documentation to be completed by department in which undergraduate certificate is sought

4. **Post-Bac grad prereq-grades and total hours:** These students are considered non-degree-seeking and take additional undergraduate coursework to raise their grade point average or to raise the number of their total undergraduate hours in preparation for admission to a graduate or professional program or to meet requirements for professional licensure.

5. **Post-Bac grad prereq-course:** These students are considered non-degree-seeking and take content-specific undergraduate courses as preparation for admission to a graduate school or professional program.
