Dean's Report

• Graduate School Working Online

- The Graduate School has transitioned into working online very well due to COVID-19.
- Dr. Kuralt reminded all of the committee members that everyone is still available in the Graduate School offices to help with any questions or issues involving curriculum, applications, letters, etc.

Applicants and Recruiting

- Keep the application process going. Try to keep converting as many applicants as possible.
- Dr. Kuralt discussed how the university's international student applications are tanking. Unfortunately, this may not change for a year due to circumstances beyond our control.
- Recruitment strategies are still in the works. This process isn't frozen.
- The Graduate School is on its own when it comes to recruitment. Full speed ahead when it comes to recruiting strategies.
 - Encourage online classes.
 - Application waiver codes are successful.
 - Professional ads are going out on Google, Facebook, LinkedIn, etc.

- Dr. Kuralt stated that she may want to get with coordinators soon to talk about the students they want to target in their own recruitment strategies.
 Advised committee members to keep an eye out for an email from her.
 - Discussion took place about taking advantage of the graduates at the undergraduate level. These individuals might be worth successfully targeting to help improve our numbers.
 - Dr. Kuralt offered committee members an opportunity for them to write up their recruiting content and the Graduate School will help with making it pretty and distributing it to their targeted audience.
 - The committee discussed that typically during times of recession, people might be more inclined to return to school.
 - Council members also talked about how they might want to be more assertive about getting people to think about continuing their education.
