Policy Proposals

- **Probation Policy -- Option 2** was approved:

Any graduate student whose cumulative GPA on all courses taken for graduate credit falls below 3.0 at the end of a semester will be placed on probation. Students will be removed from probation when their cumulative GPA is a 3.0 or above. Failure to make at least a 3.0 in each semester while on probation or receiving two or more C grades (or lower) during the probation period will result in the student being dismissed from the Graduate School. During their first semester on probation, students must meet with a graduate school advisor in addition to their program advisor to develop a plan to regain good academic standing.

- Transcript Policy

The subcommittee debated whether it would change our ability to predict applicant success in grad school if we use a GPA based only on the last 60 hours versus the cumulative GPA. Dr. Berry said he would try to get data to answer this question.

Topic is tabled until the next meeting; Dr. Berry and Dr. Kuralt will meet to figure out how to modify admissions policy.

Dean's Report

Dr. Berry:

- Dr. Berry has recently mediated several disagreements between students and their thesis or dissertation advisors. He is concerned that we don't have approved procedures for dealing with these types of conflicts.
- The council suggests looking at general student appeal legislation to see if the legislation applies to graduate students as well.

Dr. Kuralt:

- A meeting will be called for all graduate coordinators during the second week of November, on Wednesday at 3:00 pm.
