Dr. Berry and Dr. Kuralt presented two policy drafts to the Council:

Graduate student probation -

Option 1:

- If a student falls below a cumulative GPA of 3.0, then they are placed on probation. They have 12 hours to raise their GPA.
- If GPA is lower, they are dismissed.
- Depends on how many hours students take in a semester.
- Students will be removed from probation when they move up from a 3.0 GPA.
 - Removed the 12 hour limit.
- Requirement that a student meets with an advisor to counsel them on the options available to them.

Option 2:

- Failure to make a 3.0 in each semester while on probation or if you receive two or more C's in a semester = dismissal.

Revision on Option 1 and 2 statements

 Discussion on rewording phrases for students to better understand the policy.

- Students are required to meet with their advisor and a graduate school advisor to discuss a plan of action to end probation/regain good academic standing.
- Need to have the wording for this ready and to the Faculty Senate by the last October meeting.
- This is being referred to the Policy Committee for the next meeting which is on October 6, 2021.

Transcript requirements for domestic applicants

- Complications arise when the Graduate school requests student's transcripts from every institution.
- Instead of requiring every transcript, the deans propose requiring transcripts from any institution in which the student received a degree (at least 60 hours of coursework).
- This policy draft will also be given to the policy committee for further consideration for the next meeting on October 6, 2021.

Dr. Finzer: Common course numbering project

- A common course nomenclature is in the process of being created to unify all schools eventually.
 - All courses will be renumbered in the following years.
 - Once this is set up at the UA system, the entire state will adopt this nomenclature.
 - Cleans up a lot of course articulation issues when transferring credit.
 - Some standards are based on the Florida department of higher Education system.
 - 10 digit codes including a 4-digit alpha character prefix, and a
 5-digit suffix for course expansion in departments.
 - Alpha codes correspond to programs, not departments.

1st character - course level 2nd and 3rd - course identifiers 4th - credit hours or place holder 5th - credit hours
