Dean's Report: Dr. Berry

- Slate: new application system will be tested during this summer. (We currently use CRM Recruit). Applications for 2023 are being taken this Fall via this new system.
- Workday team is in the process of developing the student platform.
 - The student portion is estimated to begin Fall 2024.
- Applications are at a level of good standing with a lot of international applications. Current students are also taking more classes.

Dr. Kuralt

- Some changes in FALL 2021 changes in SAP policy holds students to more standards to keep their financial aid.
- Pace of progression required credit hour completion.
 - Must successfully complete 67% of UALR credit hours to complete their degree.
 - If the students fall below the 67% threshold, they will lose their eligibility for federal loans
 - Maximum time frame once they have reached the maximum amount of hours, they will also be ineligible for federal loans
 - Graduate/Doctoral/EDS students are allowed 135 hours
 - It's not clear in the current handout whether all graduate students are allowed 135 hours, or whether there is a lower number for master's students
 - Advisors should carefully monitor student hours as they approach this limit and warn them of the potential to lose their loan eligibility.
 - Undergrad GPA requirement 2.0
 - Graduate PhD GPA requirement 3.0
 - Graduate students need to be aware that if they fall below 3.0 GPA, they will receive an email from the university informing them that they are no longer eligible for federal loans
 - Students should document in detail all extenuating circumstances that might have caused their GPA issues so they can appeal the SAP decision before the next semester starts.
