- Declining enrollment.
- Budget decisions reflect this the budget is a direct consequence of declining enrollment.
- We need to stabilize enrollment or find ways to increase it.
- Groupings of programs within colleges:
  - Many programs have had a decline in enrollment.
  - Trying to revitalize and improve these programs to bring them back.
  - Many programs have been steady, but have relatively no growth.
    - Trying to figure out ways to improve those programs with resources and funds to make them more accessible and appeal to students.
- All people in these programs should be invested in enrollment to advocate and advertise on their program's behalf.
- Because of the decline in enrollment, there is limited funding to support innovations and new faculty, which causes conflicts because it prevents programs from bettering themselves to attract more students.
