*Last Semester*

- Take the SLPI

Students who achieve a level of Intermediate or higher

- have met the benchmark and continue with Year 3 coursework.

*Apply for graduation*

- 2.0 in all major courses.
- 2.0 in all core courses.

*Begin Program of Study*

- Meet with advisor after declaration to complete a plan of study.
- Transfer Students: Meet with advisor to complete process for transfer of credits.
- ASL Placement Test: For those entering the program with previous ASL coursework or background.

#### BA Degree

*Last Semester*

- Internship

*Apply for Graduation*

- Take the EIPA - written exam.
- 2.0 in all major courses.
- 2.0 in all core and minor courses.

*Prior to Internship*

- Take the QAST again.
- Sign up to take the EIPA written exam.

*At the end of Year 3 Courses*

- Take the QAST
- Students who achieve a QAST I/I or higher
- have met the benchmark and continue with Year 4 coursework.
