- ❖ 120 hours are required to graduate (30 hours must be taken at UA Little Rock)
- ❖ 34 credit hours of Psychology coursework (of which 16 hours must be at UA Little Rock)
- ❖ 45 of the 120 hours must be upper level hours (3000 & 4000 level)
- ❖ Must have a minor or a 2nd major.
- ❖ Must complete 2000 level proficiency in a foreign language
- ❖ Students must see an advisor every semester prior to registration.
- ❖ A grade point average of 2.0 is required in the major, the minor, and overall.
- ❖ Developmental courses do not count toward graduation. These courses start with 0, such as MATH 0301.
- ❖ Associate Degrees do not fulfill minor requirements.

***Please note that these changes may impact the number of psychology upper level courses required for graduation.**
