The specifications seem to call for specific colors, but do not specify the grade of paint. For example, if purchased from Sherwin Williams, there are multiple options which vary quite a bit in price; eg., SuperPaint, ProMar 200, ProMar 400, Property Solutions, etc. If I choose a more expensive option than my competitors, I am disadvantaged relative to competitive pricing.

Paint grade must be ProMar 200.

The specifications seem to not necessarily specify the paint manufacturer, as any paint supplier can match those colors. For example, since my company uses thousands of gallons of PPG paint per year, we can potentially supply you a superior paint from them at a lower price than Sherwin Williams.

Section 2.2 specified Sherwin Williams as the paint manufacturer.
