Bid Title: Solid Waste and Trash Removal Services

The following questions were received regarding the above-referenced bid. Responses are provided for clarification. This document is provided as a supplement to the original bid and should be reviewed by all prospective bidders. Answers are provided below in **RED**.

Questions and Answers

Q: Is the supplier expected to provide trash receptacles?

A: Yes, the supplier is responsible for providing *all* trash receptacles related to the services solicited within FB-25-029.

Q: Are there any recycling dumpsters?

A: Yes, the university currently has 4 recycling dumpsters.

Q: Will a gate access device be provided for the truck?

A: Yes, a clicker will be needed to access the housing gates, which are always closed.

Q: What is the preferred pickup time, and when do faculty and staff begin arriving on campus?

A: After-hours pickup is preferred. Employees typically begin arriving around 7:00 AM.

Q: Are there any additional services being requested outside of standard waste and recycling?

A: There may be interest in adding sustainable initiatives in the future, but those are not within the current scope of this bid.

Q: Is there potential for additional dumpsters to be added later?

A: There may be an opportunity to add more dumpsters in the future, but there are no current plans.

Q: Are all dumpsters front-load?

A: Yes, all are front-load except for the roll-offs.

Q: How many roll-off dumpsters are currently on campus?

A: There are 3 to 4 roll-off dumpsters currently in use on campus.

Q: How often is pickup required for dorms?

A: Pickup is required six days a week for all dorms.

Q: Who should the supplier contact for issues or concerns, and who will contact the supplier about issues and concerns?

A: Greg Tatera is the primary contact for any issues or concerns from both the supplier and the university.

Q: Are there photos available of the cans located behind roll-up doors in dorms?

A: Yes, photos of the cans behind roll-up doors are available under Addendum #2.

Q: Is there any type of caddy used for the roll-up dumpsters?

A: Yes, an electric caddy is used for roll-up bins (6 cu yd) in West Hall. North and South Hall do not have a caddy; the bins are 8 cu yd.

Q: Are all of the frontload containers (talls or dockstyle)?

A: There is a mixture of the 8-yard dumpsters- most have sliding doors on the sides. Department highly recommends revisiting the campus to look at the dumpsters in person.

Q: How often is "As Needed" services rendered? Typically in the summer, and if so will they be scheduled on-call or monthly – possibly once a week?

A: As needed Service is just that, no typical schedule - it could be an on call basis . An example is a highly attended event at the arena that would require an extra dumpster for just one day or a week, with pickups daily.
