

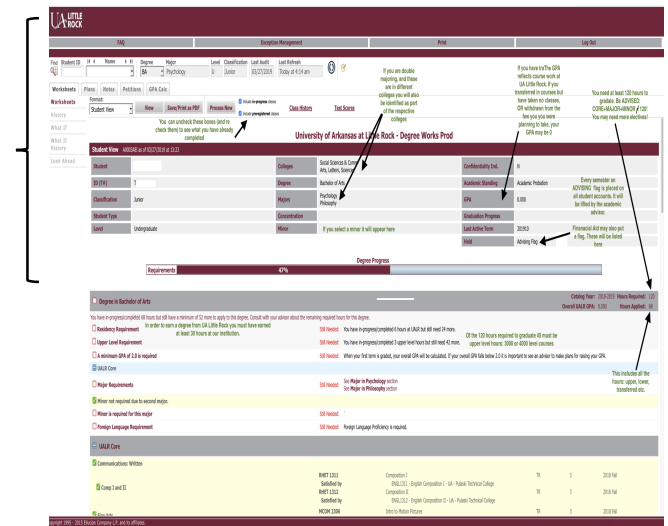

The Basics

- Residency: To graduate from UA Little Rock, at least 30 credit hours must be earned here. This is called a residency requirement.
- To graduate you are required, by State law, to earn at least 120 hours.
- Of the required 120 hours, at least 45 hours must be upper level hours: courses that start with 3 or 4 (for example 3350 or 4565).

How many hours does it all add up to?

- Most Core classes add up to about 35 hours (these vary by College)
- Most majors are about 35 hours
- Most minors are about 20 hours
- So: **$35 + 35 + 20 = 90$ hours**
- You need at least 120 hours to graduate, so you **may be short by 30**
 - $(120 - 90 = 30$ hours, or 10 3-credit classes)
- This means that you may need to take more courses than are required by each of your degree requirements.
 - Usually, these can be lower or upper level courses.
 - Transfer courses may count towards some of these hours.

Core

- Each College has a slightly different Core. This is the result of the respective expectations of the majors that are housed in that College.
- The following is the Core for the Colleges of Liberal Arts and Sciences and the College of Social Sciences and Communication.

This "squiggle" means it is in progress and near completed. When completed it will turn into a green check

TR means the course was transferred from another College
This number indicates the number of credits the course is earning or can earn

ENR means Enrolled. When the course is completed the grade will replace the ENR

Majors and Minors

- Psychology requires that you declare a minor – a second area of concentrated study.
 - You can decide to declare a second major instead – that is, a second area in which you will gain expertise.
- Psychology also requires foreign language expertise – up to the intermediate level. That is 3 3credit courses: 1311, 1312, and 2311.
 - That requirement will only be met (and checked off on your Degree Plan) after you have enrolled in and then completed the third course.
- When you declare a major and a minor (or a double major) your Degree Plan populates the required courses for these areas.
