**PSYC 20043 - (was 2300) Psychology and the Human Experience**

Three credit hours.

Was **PSYC 2300**. Focuses on the development of the individual in the context of physical and social environments. Topics include the scientific method and its application to the study of the individual, the relationship between brain and behavior, social and personality development, theories of motivation, maladaptive behavior, social cognition and interaction, and the effects of membership in different groups. Students learn through writing, reading, discussing, listening, and participating in critical thinking and problem-solving activities. (ACTS was **PSYC 1103**)
