1st Annual Racial Attitudes Cover Art Contest

The winning design will be the cover of the 2012 Racial Attitudes in Pulaski County survey report. In addition the winner will receive a monetary prize of \$100.

Guidelines

- ⇒ This contest is open to **Arkansas high school, undergraduate, and graduate students and UALR alumni**. Up to three entries per person may be submitted.
- ⇒ Submissions must be original 8 1/2 " by 11", COLOR artwork of vertical orientation. Artwork can be submitted via mail, in-person or email. Artwork can be submitted in pdf format with a color proof. Only unframed paintings, drawings, and collages will be considered. Photographs and sculptures are not appropriate for this competition. Artwork will be judged on the basis of color, technique, and ability to print well as a memorable survey report cover.
- ⇒ The cover design artwork should include "Racial Attitudes in Pulaski County, Ninth Annual Study, Focus on Media, March 2012, the UALR logo, University of Arkansas at Little Rock, Institute on Race and Ethnicity
- ⇒ Entries are due on or before **February 9, 2012**.

How To Enter

- ⇒ Fill in one entry label for each submission and attach it to the back of each submission. Additional labels should be photocopied, if needed. Artwork without labels will not be considered. If artwork is submitted via email, please include the information requested in the box below in the submission email.
