  - A. Debra Simpson-Webster from HR
    - 1. Open Enrollment (over at 10:20 a.m.)
      - Open enrollment begins Monday, October 25<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at 12 p.m.
      - Benefits eligible employees will receive a task in Workday that says open enrollment has begun.
      - HR will host meetings throughout the open enrollment period to answer questions.
      - Tobacco surcharge If an individual fails to complete the attestation or attests that they are a tobacco user then there is a \$50 surcharge.
      - Employees can make changes to their benefit plans including adding and removing people from their plan during the open enrollment period.
        - Documentation is required to add dependents.
      - Changes will be made effective January 1, 2022.
      - If employees have no changes they still must complete the tobacco attestation in Workday.
      - Employees can reach out to HR for any needed accommodations in completing open enrollment.
      - There are three major changes in benefits for this open enrollment period.
        - Vision Insurance
          - The carrier is changing from Superior Vision to EyeMed effective 1/1/2022.
        - Employees will be allowed to increase their optional life insurance coverage or opt in to the coverage at up to 3x their salary with no evidence of insurability.
        - Voluntary short-term disability coverage will be offered 1/1/2022.
          - Short term disability pays 60% of pre-disability annual salary.
          - The carrier will be the Standard.
        - Employees must reenroll in flexible spending in order for it to continue.
        - No changes are being made to dental or the retirement plan.
