General Information

- Roger Phillips Act – 2009
 - In-State Public Schools AA & AS degrees satisfy general education core
 - ⊘ AAS and AGS degrees must be reviewed course by course
 - ⊘ In-State Private Schools and Out-Of-State School must be reviewed course by course
- Changes in Core
 - Old Core (Fall 2014 and past)
 - New Core (Spring 2015 and beyond)
- Transfer Evaluation System (TES)
 - The TES process
 - Building the Transfer Equivalency Guide
- Move to Degree Works
 - BOSS/Individual Degree Adjustment (IDA) process (Summer 2017 and past)
 - Degree Works/Petitions (Fall 2017 and beyond)

The Undergraduate Transcript Flow

Admissions receives the transcript

Records types each course into the student information system

Courses appear on the UA Little Rock transcript

OTSS evaluates courses for general education core and sends non-core to departments for evaluation

What Transfers to UA Little Rock

- Courses taken at regionally accredited institutions.
- Courses with grades of “C” or higher
 - For Classes in which a “D” is acceptable at UA Little Rock, students may request to transfer up to six hours via the D Transfer Policy. Required form must be signed by student’s academic advisor
- Military and technical credits will not automatically transfer to the UA Little Rock transcript, but once a student has declared a major, the major advisor may request to have applicable military or technical courses posted.

When OTSS Evaluates Credit

- OTSS can evaluate credit and make adjustments in either BOSS or Degree Works once all official transcripts have been submitted.
- OTSS can provide unofficial core evaluations for prospective students or for academic advisors that have specific questions for advising purposes.

General Education Core

- UA Little Rock Core Curriculum
 - 35 Credit hours
 - 9 Areas of Discipline
 - English Language Communication Written (6 Hours)
 - Social Science (3 Hours)
 - History of Civilization (3 Hours)
 - US History/Government (3 Hours)
 - Fine Arts (3 Hours)
 - Humanities (3 Hours)
 - Math (3 Hours)
 - Science and Lab (8 Hours)
 - Flex (3 Hours)

How OTSS Makes a Decision

- CORE or NON-CORE
- TES or IDA/Petition
- Re-Articulate or Satisfy
 - Re-articulate to a UA Little Rock core equivalency
 - ENGL 1300 – Freshman English = RHET 1311 – Composition I
 - Re-articulate to a UA Little Rock core shell
 - PHYS 1401 – Physical Science = CORE SCIN – Core Science
 - Satisfy a UALR core area
 - PHIL 1310 – Intro to Philosophy = PHIL 1310 – Intro to Philosophy
 - »But can be used to satisfy the UA Little Rock Humanities core area.

TES: Core & Non-Core Process

- CORE

- Review for equivalency based on faculty provided rubrics
- Review to satisfy for in-state based on State Minimum Core (SMC)
- Review to satisfy for out-of-state using SMC rules approved by faculty senate
- OTSS sends to Records to post for student in TEG

- NON-CORE

- Sent to department for review
- Department reviews course for equivalency
- Department reviews course as departmental shell – PSYC 2000
- Department reviews course as elective course – TRAN 1000
- OTSS sends to Records to post for student in TEG

 - How to Interpret OTSS comments

 - OTSS scanned documents
- Transfer Evaluation System (TES)
 - Courses that have been reviewed
- Degree Audit/BOSS or DegreeWorks
 - Read and Interpret the Degree Audit/Worksheet

 - UALR: CORE FINA Core Fine Arts TR
